Kotlin

Two new APIs rely on Kotlin.

Review API

If I am going to do all the other work, I may as well get my rating up.

Billing API

The latest version also uses Kotlin coroutines.

Dropbox update

Dropbox will soon be releasing yet another version of its API. I designed the latest version of the Dropbox screen with change in mind, so the impact should be minimal.

Jakarta Mail

This is a more official version of my own port of Javamail. I doubt that it will change much, but I may as well give it a go.

PHP upgrades

The web server is running three separate PHP apps, which use different ways to access MySQL. MultiPHP is a feature of Apache, which would allow me to run a different version of PHP for each app, though some changes will be required.

BT printing

The app used to support full size wifi printers, which was useless for most purposes. I intend instead to support thermal bluetooth printers, of which there is a wide range.

New manual

The current manual and user guide are both badly out of date, and I intend to merge the two.

iOS freeware

The code for the iOS client is written in Objective-C, which is now obsolete. I intend to relaunch it as freeware.
